The Municipality of Avlonos is located on the east coast of Evia Island, a two-hour driving from Athens. It consists of ten picturesque villages spread in a magnificent area close to the Aegean Sea and Avlonari is the main village. When you approach Avlonari, you will be impressed by the church of St. Nicolas standing on the top of the hill next to the medieval tower witnessing the long-lasting Venetian domination. Once there, you will have the chance to admire the Byzantine & Venetian era monuments (e.g. St. Dimitrios church), the ever green landscape, the long white beaches as well as to enjoy the delicious and healthy food.



Our people

From Avlonari, you can enjoy daily trips to the whole island (e.g. the prehistoric "dragon-houses" in Styra or the alpine vegetation on Mount Dirfis) but the people of Avlonari will win your heart with their warm hospitality. The wider area of Avlonos is well-known for the yearly "trade fair" and the religious festivities with special food, drinks, live music and dancing! The majority of the inhabitants are farmers or work in the nearby electricity and cement factories. Despite their humble jobs, they support the schools' initiatives by all means and they are always willing to contribute morally and materially to the various out-of-curriculum activities. Thus, they "produce" enough scientists to cover all the necessary positions in the area.



Our school

As for the education, there are all types of primary, secondary and post-secondary education institutions. The General Lyceum of Avlonari offers upper secondary, general education to students aged 16-18 years old. After graduation, they can simply enroll to any post-secondary institution or they have to take state exams to enter a university school.

The new building is 1,500 sq.m. and it was finished in 2005. The upper floor hosts the classes and laboratories for computers, photography and pottery. The ground floor hosts the administrative premises, the library, the special events hall, the laboratory for physics etc. The classes are always in the mornings while the students have the chance to attend support lessons in the afternoons.

There are about 15 teachers and 100 students of both genders. Classes are from 8:15 a.m. to 13:50 p.m., Monday to Friday, from September to May; final exams take place from mid May to mid June. Holidays last two weeks for Christmas and Easter and two months for summer.

Besides their curriculum classes, students can have optional subjects like environment, fine arts, career consulting, European citizenship etc. Every year, the students participate in the program "Youth Parliament". Also, they develop environmental programs (e.g. agrotourism, water management etc) supported by European Union through the Aegean University of Greece (photo below). They often participate in European programs (e.g. "Democratic Citizenship" or "Eumotions") which give to the students and the teachers the chance to travel abroad and mix with other cultures. They create or act theatrical plays about politics and the future; they make documentaries about racism and intolerance and they present their work to wider community.
